SHORT COURSE METERS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Eleventh Annual Electric City Invitational was also designated as the first Dixie Zone Short Course Meters Championship. The meet was held on November 6-7 at the Sheppard Swim Center in Anderson, South Carolina.

Representing 26 Masters teams from 11 states, 134 swimmers competed in the meet. The Raleigh Area Masters won the team championship by the narrow margin of 940 to 923 over the defending champion Parris Island Masters. The Palmetto Masters, Georgia Masters, and the Aquatic Team of Mecklenburg placed third through fifth, respectively.

John Kortheuer of Charlotte, NC and the Mecklenburg Aquatic Club set a world record of 1:22.40 in the 60-64 men's 100 meter breaststroke. Roxanne Motter of the Bristol Y Masters set a USMS record of 35.17 in the 60-64 women's 50 meter freestyle. Many Dixie Zone records and Top Ten times were no doubt established as well.

In addition to all of the excellent swimming, the Anderson Masters hosted an ice cream social immediately after Saturday's events, a dinner and drawing for prizes on Saturday night, and a sub sandwich special after Sunday's events. Each swimmer attending the meet received an Electric City Invitational seat cushion.

We hope that everyone enjoyed their weekend at the Dixic Zone Championships in Anderson.

AROUND THE DIXIE ZONE

Florida LMSC - The Shade UVA Guard Team Orlando Masters Short Course Meters Invitational Swim Meet was held in October at the International Drive YMCA and Aquatic Center in Orlando. The more than 190 Masters swimmers that attended this extremely competitive event saw 17 WORLD and 13 NATIONAL records fall. The Holmes Lumber Jax team took the combined team honors with Team Orlando a close second behind. Team Orlando's coach Lucky Meisenheimer was extremely pleased with the meet and received many comments. His only concern was: "What do I do with the extra keg of beer we got for the social?"

Florida Gold Coast LMSC - Jack Nelson was recently named Man-of-the-Year by the Greater Fort Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce. Jack is a Fort Lauderdale institution as coach of the Fort Lauderdale Swim Team and for his distinguished lifetime of commitment to swimming. Thirty-six Nelson proteges have competed in the Olympics, including several gold medalists and American record-setters.

Georgia LMSC - The Georgia Masters continue to meet regularly to plan a bid presentation for the 1996 USMS Short Course Nationals. The site of the meet would be, of course, the new Olympic facility. The next meeting will be held on February 3 - give Lisa Watson a call for more information. Olympic Pool notes: The covered facility will permanently seat 4,000 spectators, with several thousand temporary seats added for the Games.

North Carolina LMSC - Plans continue for the 1994 Dixie Zone Short Course Yards Championships to be held at the Pullen Aquatic Center in Raleigh on April 16-17 (entry form enclosed). Dixie members are reminded to donate old and unused awards (medals preferred) at the meet for use in the Awards Across America program. A social will be held on Saturday night at the Brownstone Hotel.

South Carolina LMSC - From South Carolina's "Wet Notes," an interesting note from the now-wife of David Parler, chairman of the SC LMSC:

LMSC GROWTH & MEMBER RETENTION

Our National Registrars, Diane and Bill Black, analyzed registrations by LMSCs toward the end of 1993 and provided the information for the USMS Board of Directors. While a number of factors impact registrations and reregistrations, USMS may be able to identify some programs or techniques employed by the high retention LMSCs which could benefit others.

How to read the report

The first section analyzes 1991 swimmer registrations. The "91rr" ('91 reregistrations) column includes those who were registered in 1991 and also in 1992. The "911o" ('91 lost) column includes those who did not reregister in 1992, and the "91t" ('91 total) column includes all those in the '91 database. The "% reregistered" column is the 1991 Reregs column divided by the 1991 Total column. The '92 columns are similar to '91.

The '93 Total column includes the swimmers registered for 1993 reported to the National Registrars by October 15, 1993. The 1993 New column summarizes those swimmers in the 1993 database who were not in the 1992 database. The 93/92 Change column is the difference between the 1992 total and the 1993 totals. The final column summarizes the reregistration percentages for 1991 and 1992 combined.

Facility:

Pullen Aquatic Center, 410 Ashe Avenuc, Raleigh, N.C. The pool is 50 meters by 25 vards with a bulkhead dividing the competition area into a 8 x 25 yard course.

Non-turbulent lane lines and electronic timing system will be used. Continuous

warm-up area will be available in the remaining 25 yard course area.

Rules:

Swimmers must be registered with U.S. Masters Swimming (USMS). A photocopy of your current 1994 registration must be attached to your entry. Registration will not be available at the meet. The 1994 USMS rules shall prevail. Each swimmer will limited to five events per day plus relays. The 19-24 age group will count towards team points. By competing, this age group may affect their U.S.S. amateur standing. Swimmers may

enter either the 1650 or the 1000 Free, not both.

Fees:

Entry fees are \$3.00 for each individual event and a \$6.00 surcharge is added for automatic timing, pool rental and zone fee. Relay fees are \$5.00. Fees must accompany entries and are non-refundable. Late and deck entries will be accepted. Late and deck entry fees will be \$6.00 per event. Make checks payable to Raleigh Area Masters. Send entries to John Armfield, 1907 Cameron Street, Raleigh, N.C. 27605.

Entry deadline to be seeded is April 5, 1994. City of Raleigh Waiver must be signed

and returned with entry.

Awards:

Awards will be given for 1st - 8th place in each age group in each event. The high point winner in each age group will receive a custom award. Team awards will be given to

the 1st - 3rd place teams and 1st place out-of-state team.

Scoring will be 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for individual events and 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2 for

Saturday, April 16, 1994 -- Warm-up for the 1650 and 1000 begins at 8:00 a.m. Heats for the 1650 and 1000 begin at 8:30 a.m. with a final check-in at 8:15 a.m. Heats will be mixed sex and swum fastest to slowest. Meet management reserves the right to re-deck seed based upon participation. Warm-up for other Saturday events will begin at

12:00 noon. Heats begin at 1:00 p.m.

Sunday, April 17, 1994 -- Warm-up begins at 8:00 a.m. and heats will begin at 9:00

a.m. A final check-in for the 500 free will be held on Sunday morning.
