FLORIDA - The Florida LMSC ailed to report the Top Ten Times for the 1996 Dixie Zone SCM Championship meet held in Orlando. The meet director claims he mailed the results to the Top Ten recorder who says he didn't get them. Both the Sanction Application and the Official Sanction state that results in the proper format shall be submitted within 14 days of the conclusion of the event. It is the responsibility of the Top Ten recorder to see that this rule (Rule Book, Appendix B: Preparation of Meet Results) is followed. This failure left out approximately 500 Top Ten Times and 30 first places for All American. And for me personally, the two times left out would have allowed me to have first place in all 18 events - something I will probably never come close to again! There were many people from both Florida Gold Coast and Florida who tried hard to get Walt Reid to accept this meet late but to no avail. I appeal to all Meet Directors - please finish your job - this includes getting the results on time to the right people!

FLORIDA GOLD COAST - Carl House is busy promoting web pages for the Internet. He has gathered pictures and stories for every one. Many of our All Americans can not be found on the Net. Take time to look into all this available information. Ernie Leskovitz has moved to Hawaii. He attended the Aussi National and reports that the Olympic pool is very fast. Ernie will return to Florida in June for the Swim Around Key West.

GEORGIA - Wow, what a meet! At 327 entries & 44 participating team, a record turnout (topping last year's record turnout of 285) that saw National records fall and exiting competition among our Georgia teams. This year, the high point team awards were divided into 2 categories: Visiting Team awards for the out-of-state teams and Georgia Team awards. There was a tough battle for the Georgia awards and finishing 1-2-3 were: Killer Whales at 1766.5 points, Atlanta Rainbow Trout at 1239 points and Dynamo Masters at 964 points. Visiting Team award finishes were in order: North Carolina Masters Swimming at 687 points, Team Greenville Masters at 568 points, and Greater Knoxville Masters Swimming at 408 points. Individual swims were also noteworthy. June Krauser of Gold Coast Masters set several National Records. State records fell right and left, so expect revisions to the Records Board displayed at Dynamo in the near future. Glenn Crooks gave us the use of his home for the social and he now shares his home with ABILARD, our beautiful grand prize pig! Thanks to all who helped to make this a great meet! Lisa writes that Georgia would like to bid for the Dixie Zone SCY Championship in 1998 at the St. Pat Meet which will be held March 14 & 15.

NORTH CAROLINA - Across The Lanes is the NC Newsletter. It is quite nice and done by Mary Craddock Hoffman. She does a great job! Nice pictures and graphics. National Records were set by John Kortheuer and Richard Bober. Placing first in the nation were Grant Johnston, Richard Bober and 2 relays. The NCMS 200 m MMR team of Jeannie Mitchell 49, Sally Newall 59, John Kortheur 65 and Dick Webber 67 set a new World SCM record with a time of 2:26.10 in the 240-279 relay.

SOUTH CAROLINA - Five swimmers from across the great state of South Carolina each have their very own page on the world wide web.
