THE SHOWDOWN DIXIE ZONE vs. COLONIES ZONE

There were 20 teams from each Zone participating in the meet. However, the Colonies Zone had 130W and 141M for a total of 271 swimmers while Dixie Zone had only 67W and 114M for a total of 181 swimmers. We were outnumbered by our northern opponents! (Team results on page 2)

The largest Dixie Zone team was the home team - Gold Coast Masters with 70 swimmers. Plantation Masters had 14 swimmers while the City of Atlanta Masters had 12 swimmers and three teams brought 10 swimmers - Crawfish Masters, Ocala Masters and Orlando Masters. The Colonies teams were much larger and could field many more relays.

A cool spell hit Florida just before the meet along with several days of clouds and rain. Even though the sun was out the air and water were a little chilly on the first day. Two courses were used in the competition pool and the training pool had lots of lanes for warm up and warm down. And if you were too cold, the diving well could also be used. The warmest water was in the hot tub or in the showers!

LMSC NEWS

FLORIDA - The Florida LMSC ailed to report the Top Ten Times for the 1996 Dixie Zone SCM Championship meet held in Orlando. The meet director claims he mailed the results to the Top Ten recorder who says he didn't get them. Both the Sanction Application and the Official Sanction state that results in the proper format shall be submitted within 14 days of the conclusion of the event. It is the responsibility of the Top Ten recorder to see that this rule (Rule Book, Appendix B: Preparation of Meet Results) is followed. This failure left out approximately 500 Top Ten Times and 30 first places for All American. And for me personally, the two times left out would have allowed me to have first place in all 18 events - something I will probably never come close to again! There were many people from both Florida Gold Coast and Florida who tried hard to get Walt Reid to accept this meet late but to no avail. I appeal to all Meet Directors - please finish your job - this includes getting the results on time to the right people!

FLORIDA GOLD COAST - Carl House is busy promoting web pages for the Internet. He has gathered pictures and stories for every one. Many of our All Americans can not be found on the Net. Take time to look into all this available information. Ernie Leskovitz has moved to Hawaii. He attended the Aussi National and reports that the Olympic pool is very fast. Ernie will return to Florida in June for the Swim Around Key West.

GEORGIA - Wow, what a meet! At 327 entries & 44 participating team, a record turnout (topping last year's record turnout of 285) that saw National records fall and exiting competition among our Georgia teams. This year, the high point team awards were divided into 2 categories: Visiting Team awards for the out-of-state teams and Georgia Team awards. There was a tough battle for the Georgia awards and finishing 1-2-3 were: Killer Whales at 1766.5 points, Atlanta Rainbow Trout at 1239 points and Dynamo Masters at 964 points. Visiting Team award finishes were in order: North Carolina Masters Swimming at 687 points, Team Greenville Masters at 568 points, and Greater Knoxville Masters Swimming at 408 points. Individual swims were also noteworthy. June Krauser of Gold Coast Masters set several National Records. State records fell right and left, so expect revisions to the Records Board displayed at Dynamo in the near future. Glenn Crooks gave us the use of his home for the social and he now shares his home with ABILARD, our beautiful grand prize pig! Thanks to all who helped to make this a great meet! Lisa writes that Georgia would like to bid for the Dixie Zone SCY Championship in 1998 at the St. Pat Meet which will be held March 14 & 15.

NORTH CAROLINA - Across The Lanes is the NC Newsletter. It is quite nice and done by Mary Craddock Hoffman. She does a great job! Nice pictures and graphics. National Records were set by John Kortheuer and Richard Bober. Placing first in the nation were Grant Johnston, Richard Bober and 2 relays. The NCMS 200 m MMR team of Jeannie Mitchell 49, Sally Newall 59, John Kortheur 65 and Dick Webber 67 set a new World SCM record with a time of 2:26.10 in the 240-279 relay.

SOUTH CAROLINA - Five swimmers from across the great state of South Carolina each have their very own page on the world wide web. That's right, due to the efforts and work of Carl House five of our swimmers each have a page on the www naming the events, when, what course, and a little history about them. SOUTHEASTERN - After the death last year of Elleen Schappel who was instrumental in running the LMSC they have been struggling to get organized. Jean Fox was the only swimmer representing Southeastern at the Showdown Meet and we thank her for coming and doing so much for the LMSC.

SOUTHERN - Scott Rabalais keeps me updated with the Crawfish Tales, the Newsletter of the Crawfish Masters Swim Team. Scott also puts on the February Fitness Challenge. Check out the numbers from the 1997 February Fitness Challenge:

- 541 swimmers entered (302 women, 239 men)
- 3 countries (US, Canada, Australia)
- 37,523,554 yards (21,320 miles) were swum
- 69,359 yards was the average per swimmer
- 47 Baton Rougeans participated (52 Crawfish)
- 630,100 yards was the first-place total
- 935 yards was the last-place yardage

The Crawfish Masters won the team title at the Southern Masters SC Championships held at the Natatorium on March 22-23. With 1,584 points, the team outscored All Acadiana Aquatics (717) and Courthouse Masters (555).

Sanctioned by Southern LMSC for USMS, Inc., sanction #247-003. The meet has been designated as the Dixie Zone and Southern LMSC Championship, and \$1 per swimmer will be allocated to the Dixie Zone.

FACILITIES

8 lane, 50 meter, indoor, 9' wide lanes and constant 7' depth. Natatorium includes 6 lane, 25 yard diving well available for warm up throughout the meet.

LOCKER ROOMS

Rest rooms and changing rooms are located in the Natatorium. Showers are not available in the Natatorium.

TIMING

Colorado electronic timing with touchpads, back-up button and stopwatch. Eight-lane scoreboard displays swimmers' name, splits, final time and place.

RULES

Current rules apply as stated in the 1997 USMS Rule Book.

ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be registered with United States Masters Swimming. A COPY OF YOUR 1997 USMS CARD MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR ENTRY.

ENTRY LIMIT

Swimmers may enter a maximum of 11 individual events with a maximum of 5 individual events each day.

Swimmers may participate in two relays (same sex and mixed) each day relays are offered.

ENTRY FEES

All entrants are required to pay an \$8.00 meet surcharge, and the cost of each individual event entered is \$2.00. There is no charge for relays. Tickets to Saturday's "Dinner at the Belle" are \$12.00 per person, payable in advance. Please make all checks payable to: BENGAL TIGER AQUATIC CLUB.

ENTRY DEADLINE

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, JULY 24. No late entries; no deck entries, and no FAX entries will be accepted. Any entry received after July 24 will be returned. Enclose a SASE for entry confirmation.

SEEDING

ALL EVENTS will be seeded by time regardless of age in heats slowest to fastest. The 1500 free will be run alternating a full heat of women and a full heat of men, and women and men may be combined in the same heat to expedite the meet. The 1500 free will be deck seeded; please check-in by 5 pm. If you will arrive after 5 pm on Friday, please notify the Meet Director prior to the meet. The 400 free will also be deck-seeded and will require check-in on Sunday by 10 a.m.

RELAYS

Each team with a sufficient number of entered swimmers will be automatically entered in the relays.

AGE GROUPS

Individual: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, etc. (five-year increments as high as necessary)
Relays: 76-99, 100-119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, etc. (forty-year increments as high as necessary)

SCORING

Individual: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay: 18-16-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

AWARDS

Each entrant will receive a participation award at check-in. Awards will be presented to the top three scoring teams.

HIGH-POINT AWARDS

Top scorers in each age group, male and female, will be presented high-point awards at the conclusion of the meet.
